BALLARAT LINE UPGRADE

The Australian and Victorian governments are upgrading the Ballarat line to deliver more trains and improved reliability for Melbourne's outer western suburbs, Melton, Bacchus Marsh, Ballan and Ballarat

UPGRADES TO WENDOUREE STATION

A second platform and new tracks will be built at Wendouree as part of the Ballarat Line Upgrade.

This will create enough space for trains to pass each other at Wendouree station for the first time, fixing the current problem that sees delayed services from Melbourne terminate at Ballarat and passengers forced onto replacement buses because trains can't pass each other beyond Ballarat.

The upgraded Wendouree station will also include a new accessible pedestrian link between the new and existing platform, and additional security, lighting and signage.

We want your feedback on the proposed station concept layout and project planning for the Wendouree station upgrade so we can understand what's important to local residents, businesses and commuters.

WHAT IS THE BALLARAT LINE UPGRADE?

The \$1.57 billion Regional Rail Revival program is a once in a generation investment that will deliver major upgrades to every regional passenger train line in Victoria and create over 1,000 jobs.

The Ballarat Line Upgrade will enable much needed extra services in the morning and afternoon peak, plus a train every 40 minutes off-peak for the growing communities along the line.

Construction started in October 2017 with the project to be completed by late 2019.

THE STATION UPGRADE WILL INCLUDE:

- An additional platform on the south side of the station
- New accessible pedestrian link between platforms
- Track duplication
- Added security features including more CCTV and lighting

Pending planning approval, construction on the Wendouree station upgrade will start in 2018 with the project to be completed by late 2019.

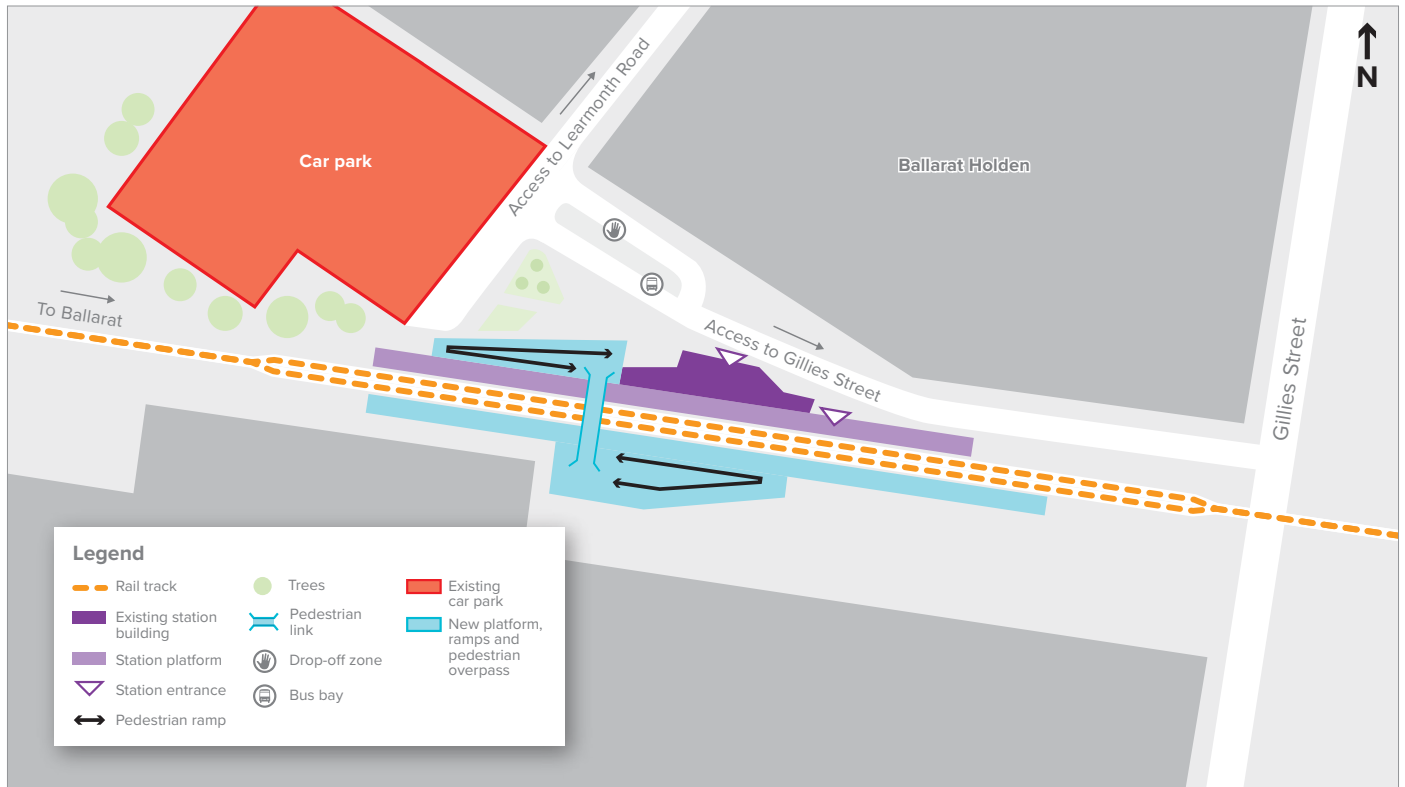
